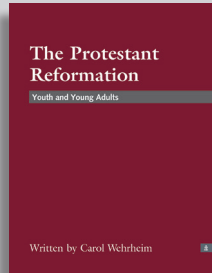
Children

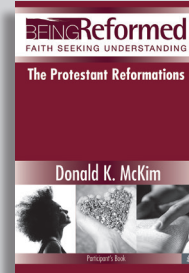


Youth and Young Adults
