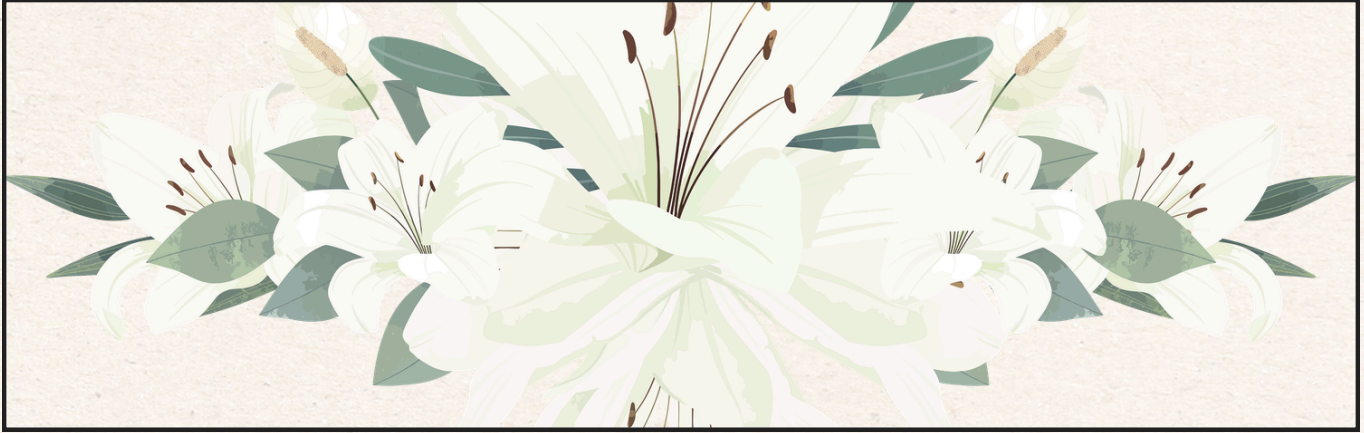

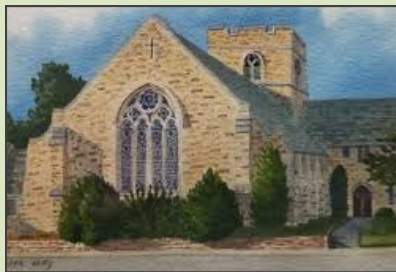

At Central Presbyterian in Princeton, our March mission focus centered on supporting Ukrainians as they continued to endure the hardships of war. Through this effort, we stood in solidarity with a people facing ongoing violence, displacement, and uncertainty. Gifts from our members helped provide practical aid, including items to keep soldiers warm in harsh conditions and supplies intended to help them reduce vulnerability to drone attacks. We offered this support as an expression of Christian compassion, praying for peace, protection, and the restoration of lives and communities.
